8. Explain fertilization till implantation in human female with neat and labeled diagrams .

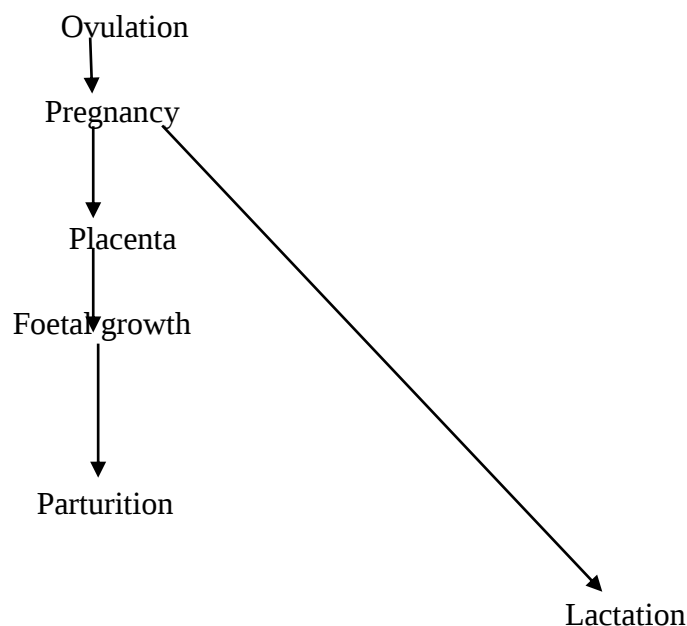
