The above sentence is an example of a particular kind of pronoun called a reflexive pronoun.

The singular reflexive pronouns are: myself, yourself, himself, herself, itself.

Plural reflexive pronouns include: Ourselves, Yourselves etc.,

More examples of reflexive pronouns:

I gave myself 12 weeks to get in shape.

You should buy yourself a new computer. I *myself* am tired of all this rain.

You *yourself* are to blame for this confusion.
