The main points that need to be incorporated while writing a Bio-sketch are:

- ☐ Full name, date of birth/age, place of birth
- ☐ Major personality traits
- ☐ Educational details highlighting any major achievements or awards
- ☐ His / Her contribution to society
- ☐ Any special interest
- ☐ Why is he/she famous or known for?

How to Write a Biographical Sketch

- ☐ All the information should be in chronological order while writing.
- ☐ Always written in the third person and in past tense.
- ☐ Heading/Title should be underlined. (Biographical sketch of.....)
- ☐ A biographical sketch is always written in one paragraph.
- ☐ No clues should be left out.
- ☐ No additional information should be included.
